

Medical Clearance for Lyric Hearing Device Candidacy

Lyric is the first completely invisible extended-wear hearing device that is worn 24 hours a day, for up to 4 months at a time. FDA approval for Lyric was obtained in 2002 and it became commercially available in January of 2008. Over 3,000 patients are successfully wearing Lyric nationwide.

Lyric resides deep in the ear canal and rests approximately 4mm from the tympanic membrane. As with any ear canal examination or hearing aid fitting, complications are rare but could include abrasion, discomfort, soreness, bleeding, infection or pain.

Because Lyric is worn continuously for up to 120 days, InSound Medical recommends that any patient reporting any of the following conditions seek medical clearance from their managing physician prior to wearing the Lyric hearing device.

- Prescription Anticoagulation Therapy
- Non-medically Managed Diabetes
- Compromised Immune System: (HIV; Advanced Lupus or RA; etc)
- Chemotherapy: (within 6 months)
