**Test instructions for the
ELECTROCOCHLEOGRAM (ECOG)**

The ECOG is a test, which measures the changes in the electrical activity of the inner part of the ear. During the ECOG, electrodes will be placed on the forehead and in your ear canal near your eardrum. Though earphones you will hear “clicking” noises. The electrodes record the inner ear nerve responses as the sound waves travel into the inner ear. Your role during the test will be to lay back and relax. This is important in order to get an accurate test.

This test is not painful and will take approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour to complete. Please wear comfortable clothing as you will be reclining on the exam table and it is very important that you are relaxed for the testing.
