

Advance Beneficiary Notice for Medicare Patients

Medicare will only pay for services that it determines to be “reasonable and necessary” under section 1862 (a) of the Medicare Law. If Medicare determines that a particular service, although it would be otherwise covered is “not reasonable and necessary” under Medicare program standards, Medicare will deny payment for that service. The following services provided by Center for Hearing & Balance and/or Liliانا C. Piccinini, Au.D. are routinely not covered by Medicare:

- *Payment of office visit charges – if related to hearing aid(s)
- *Hearing aid clean and check visits
- *Hearing aid repairs
- *Deductible on lost hearing aid claim
- *Removal of impacted wax
