

Directions from North of Warwick

Take 95 South. Look for EXIT 12B and stay to the right. This will merge you onto I-295 North toward Route 2. Stay in this lane for half a mile, then take EXIT 1B. This merges with Route 2/Bald Hill Road. Continue to stay to the right, which will lead you into the Warwick Mall, then take the first left. At the stop sign you should see Macy's directly in front of you. After this left turn, make the first left into the Warwick Medical Building parking lot. There are two entrances into the building; Go into the entrance with the carport. Take the elevators up to the second floor. We are right on the left as you step off the elevator.



Directions from South of Warwick

Take 95 North. Look for EXIT 11, which exits on the left side of the highway. This will merge you onto I-295 North toward Route 2. Take this road for one mile, then take EXIT 1B. This merges with Route 2/Bald Hill Road. Continue to stay to the right, which will lead you into the Warwick Mall, then take the first left. At the stop sign you should see Macy's directly in front of you. After this left turn, make the first left into the Warwick Medical Building parking lot. There are two entrances into the building; Go into the entrance with the carport. Take the elevators up to the second floor. We are right on the left as you step off the elevator.
